- 1. The specifications mention that Exhibit 1 would include the maps needed however there is not Exhibit 1 included the documents. Can the maps be provided?

  Answer: Please see attached map at the end of the document.
- 2. Is forestry mowing permitted outside of the high-quality areas?

  Answer: Yes, it can be used; however, most of the invasive is under control and not really needed, but we can discuss later if the job is awarded to a contractor who wants to use one.
- 3. Will trees that are selected for thinning be marked prior to the bid due date? **Answer:** Some are tagged but it is ongoing we will tag throughout the contract.
- 4. Brush pile burning is listed as a disposal method, is brush pile burning acceptable in the high-quality areas by hand?


Answer: Yes

- 5. Can you provide a more detailed map, especially outlining the higher quality areas? **Answer:** More detailed maps will be provided as needed to whomever contract is awarded to.

- 8. Can you clarify Bid Form Item 5, Native Species Enhancement, "included in Specification; not under contract"? Is the work outlined in the bid document regarding Native Species?
